



Direct Support Professional for Residential Programs (full/part time) –

These positions provide support to people with developmental disabilities in a variety of residential settings. Duties include teaching people daily living skills which will help them to become more independent. Some of these skills could include, but are not limited to: personal hygiene, cooking, cleaning, doctor's appointments, assisting with finances and recreational/social support.

Requirements include:

- a minimum of a high school diploma
- valid driver's license (relatively clean driving record)
- reliable transportation
- cell phone
- must be able to work evenings and weekends

Relief Direct Support Professional (part time 0-40hrs) –

These positions are similar to a regular Direct Support Professional in area of work setting as well as responsibilities; however, the hours are not guaranteed. These would be considered similar to a "substitute" position. Requirements are also the same.
